Part 3 – Text 2

Livestock in their hundreds have had to swim to safety or perish throughout the New South Wales Northern Rivers this week but despite the awful images coming out of the record 2022 flood on the Richmond River, there are some rays of hope. At Tuncester, NSW, dairy farmer Paul Weir has been overwhelmed by the generosity of neighbours and complete strangers in helping the family get back to milking.

When the floodwater rose early Monday half the family's Holstein herd swam for their lives, despite standing in the stables, built above record flood levels. About 150 cows remained in the yard and stoically survived the deluge. In the days since, as waters receded, the Weir family have retrieved about two-thirds of their original herd, and thanks to generous offers from fellow farmers they are able to be milked, while a livestock carrier organised transport to deliver the animals to safer country. Meanwhile offers of hay from Northern Victoria are being delivered.

Norco Rural field services consultant Bruce Lyle set up a "Livestock and items lost and found" page on Facebook at the start of the floods and the site now has nearly 1000 members communicating lost livestock and found, not drowned, mostly cattle that have swum dozens of kilometres down the Richmond River.

Part 3 – Text 3

The Irish Farmers' Association (IFA) has urged the government to take legislative action to prevent below-cost selling of food. IFA president Tim Cullinan addressed the parliamentary Committee on Agriculture this week. "Farmers are faced with exorbitant increases in the cost of energy, feed and fertiliser. Between this and the action from retailers, it's creating undue and unfair pressure on our primary producers," Cullinan said. "Unless government action is taken, these challenges pose a significant threat to the viability of primary food production across the pig, poultry, horticulture and potato sectors."

"Over 90% of our beef and dairy products are exported and are doing better in world markets than farmers supplying fresh produce within our own country." Cullinan said the government must stop below-cost selling and implement this into Irish law. "It's a sad day when Irish consumers are purchasing fruit and vegetables brought in from external markets, when so much more could be done to support our own," he said.
